19.18 To receive apologies for absence.

- 21.18 To agree the minutes of the meeting held on Thursday 19 October 2017
 Agreed and signed
- 22.18 To consider the quotations received for heightened fencing round the multi-use games area at Woody Heights recreation ground

 Councillor Ward is waiting for one more quotation which will include the cost of intermediate posts. The 3 quotes will then be considered as there are enough funds available
- To consider CCTV at Woody Heights recreation ground
 For there to be a CCTV camera installed at Woody Heights a power supply would be needed in the form of a wind turbine /solar panel or an electricity supply. The committee will recommend to Full Council that an electricity supply would be the best option as this would be useful for other uses in the future. Councillor Ward agreed to obtain quotes.
- 24.18 To consider floodlights at the skatepark on Woody Heights recreation ground

The provision of floodlighting will be given further consideration after the possibility of an electricity supply has been looked into as this would be a big project with the need for a public consultation, planning application and the installation of power.
